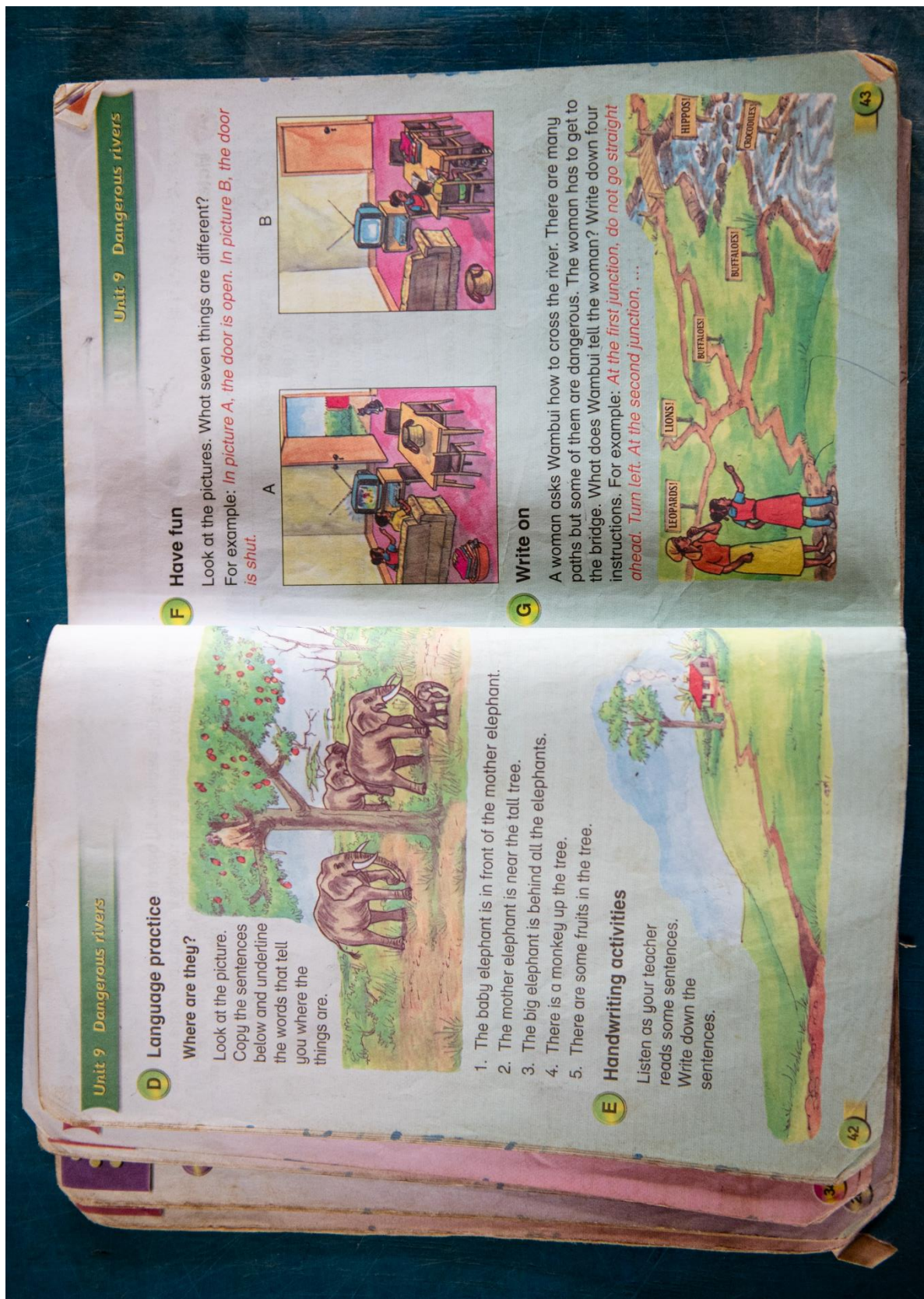

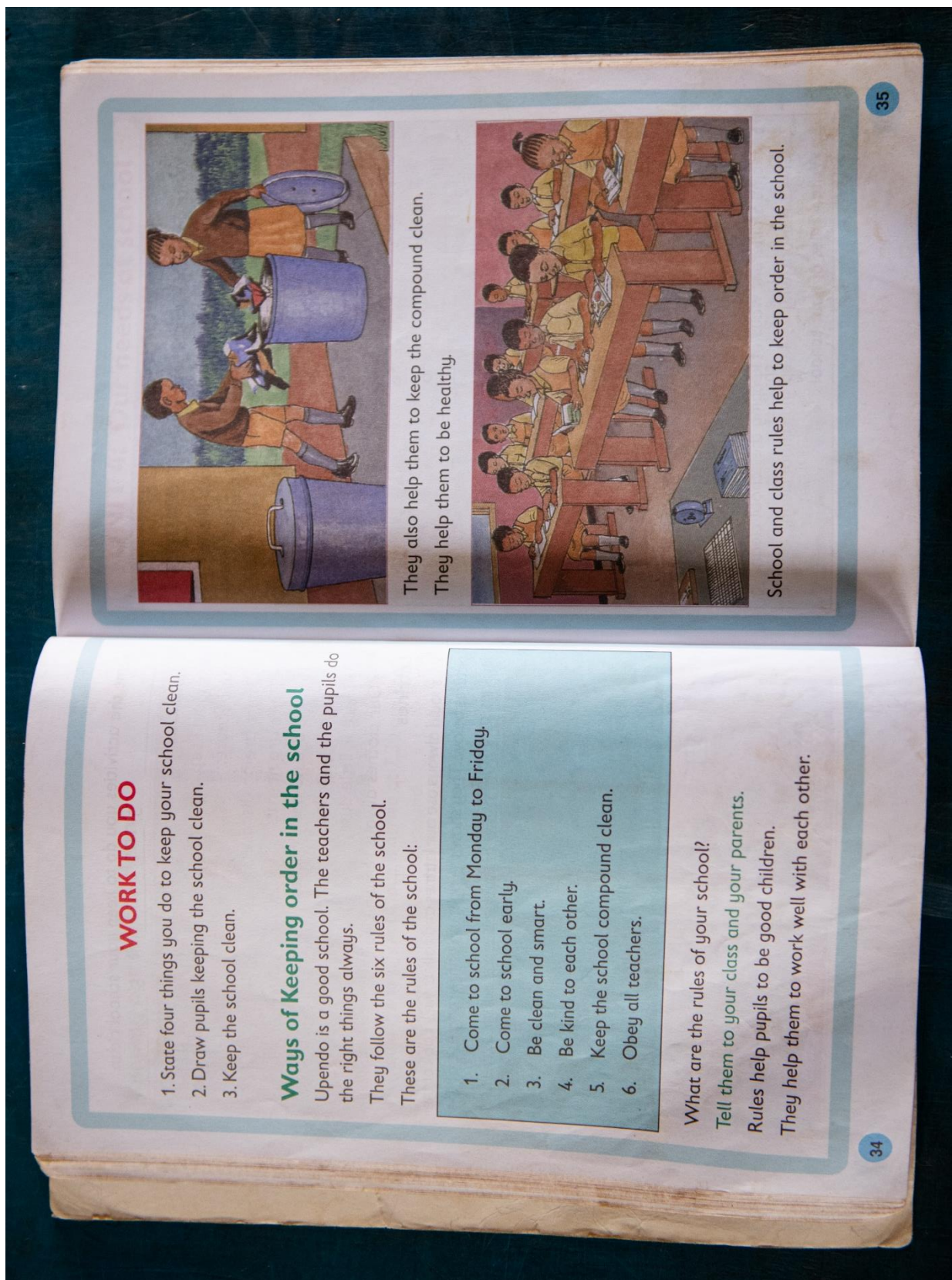

Plants

**A** Germination

We need plants for food and beauty. Let us protect them.

Putting seeds in the soil is called **planting**.  
Seeds will change into plants if you look after them properly.  
Changing of seeds into young plants is called **germination**.  
Young plants are called **seedlings**.

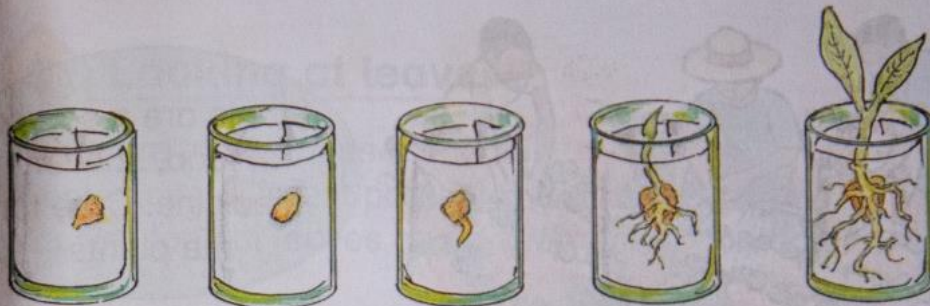

**Picture 4** Looking at germinating seeds

Make the toilet paper wet by pouring in some drops of water.  
Put drops of water on your seeds everyday.

Look at your seeds everyday. After how long do they start to germinate?

Draw the seeds after five days, then after seven days and then after ten days.

## **B** Caring for plants

When the plants begin to grow, you must look after them.

Some other plants that are not needed may also grow.

These plants are called **weeds**.

You must remove all the weeds.

Weeds use the food that plants need.

### **BE SAFE!**

Some seeds and fruits are poisonous.  
Do not put seeds in your mouth.





Plants are a source of food, shelter, medicine. Care for the plants

**Picture 5** *Caring for plants*

Plants die without water. Plants must be given enough water.

Rain gives water to the plants.



**Picture 6** *Plants do not grow well if there is too much water*

Too much water is bad for plants. Our plants may not grow well. We must remove some water if there is too much water by making sure it flows away.

Some small animals will want to eat the plants. You must remove these small animals.

We also protect our plants from big animals by putting a fence round the plot.
